Purpose and legal foundation

Based on UAE laws and regulations, including Federal Law No. 3 of 2016 concerning Child Rights (Wadeema Law).

Policy objectives

- Protect children from abuse, neglect and exploitation.
- Raise awareness of children's rights and protection mechanisms.
- Provide clear arrangements for reporting safeguarding concerns.
- Comply with applicable national and international child-protection requirements.

Child rights covered by protection

Right	What it includes
Basic	Life, name, nationality and a dignified life.
Family	Family care, custody and financial support.
Health	Necessary healthcare and protection from disease.
Education	Education and protection from school dropout.
Cultural	Age-appropriate cultural and scientific participation.

Types of abuse

Type	Meaning
Physical	Intentional physical harm, such as hitting or burning.
Psychological	Intimidation, bullying, humiliation or belittling.
Neglect	Failure to meet basic needs such as food, education or medical care.
Exploitation	Using a child for personal or financial gain, including child labour.

Reporting a concern

Any concern about a child's safety or wellbeing must be reported promptly and handled sensitively, with information shared only with those responsible for safeguarding and follow-up.
