Clear expectations, supportive responses and shared responsibility

DEAR STUDENT Your commitment to positive behaviour and school values helps create a safe, supportive and successful school community.

Level	Expected behaviour	Support / handling
1	Punctuality; preparation; commitment; respect; care for environment.	Verbal reminder; in-class reflection; mentoring support.
2	Academic integrity; kindness; self-regulation; policy compliance; peaceful peer relations.	Tutor/Key Stage discussion; parent notification; collaborative action plan; counsellor guidance.
3	Safety; honesty; responsibility; respect for property and school reputation.	Parent-school conference; Individual BMP; restorative agreement / guided community service.
4	Exemplary citizenship; preventing harassment; full compliance with ADEK and school policies.	Urgent Leadership/Disciplinary review; formal parent meeting; ADEK-aligned intervention; counselling and behavioural contract.

Responses should be fair, proportionate, supportive and consistently documented. Student safety, dignity and learning remain central to all behaviour decisions.
